She studied philosophy at St. Andrews went on to win a Carnegie Scholarship to study literature at Cambridge where she was a supervisor in Tragedy for some years. She then worked as a Jungian analyst and co-authored a book, *The Myth of the Goddess*, exploring the mythic images of the feminine principal in western history.

She will discuss the premise that some of the challenges facing women at work can be traced to the collective prejudices against the feminine over the last 4000 years - particularly in the Judeo-Christian tradition - which amount almost to a “mythological conditioning” that we all need to understand.
